Short Guide for Applicants

Before Applying, please :



Select song from the Project Website for your artiste.



Attain a copy of the lyrics for the cover application.



Prepare the signed Artiste Credential Confirmation Form.



Apply for cover version rights from music publishers, obtain written confirmation.
Publishing information may be available at www.cash.org.hk *








Note: Must notify the publisher(s) that the application is for this Scheme, as each song is restricted to just one subsidy project.

Before Applying, please :



-  Select Studio Practitioners, agreed with each other on the upper limit on wage/fee.
-  Ensure to engage 6 or more Studio Practitioners. Total fees per song is preferable to be more than HK\$48,960 together.
-  Prepare the signed Practitioner Credential Confirmation Form.
-  Note: Each Studio Practitioner **can only receive a maximum subsidy of HK\$80,000** irrespective of the number of jobs engaged under the Scheme.
-  Non-member applicant : **Must obtain 2 signed written recommendations from 2 Full Member of the IFPI (Hong Kong Group) Limited.**

Application Form entries



Download the Application Form, complete and sign both the Application Form and the Rules and Regulations.

Ensure all entries have met the Project requirements before submission.

Applicant decides how many Artistes and songs to apply. Indicate priority for each Artiste and song.

Attention :



- Incomplete application will be rejected.
- Revised application shall be considered as a new application.
- All Applications, once verified as being valid is assigned a time stamp for processing on rolling basis.
- Each Applicants would only be granted 1 project title during the Application Period while quota lasts.
- Un-allocated valid applications already received would be considered at the Closing of the Application Period, if quota remains open.

A two-stage confirmation process

- Successful application will receive a written confirmation form from the Organizer.
- Applicant must submit to the Organizer the paid-up cover license issued by the music publishers within 7 working days from above.

The Check List



- A signed copy of the completed Application Form and the Rules and Regulation.
 - A copy of the lyrics to be used for the cover recording.
- Evidence of cover version licence from the Music Publishers (Song/Lyrics).
 - Artiste Credential Confirmation Form, signed.
- Practitioner Credential Confirmation Form, signed.
 - Non-Member only : Written Recommendation from 2 Organizer's Full Members, signed.
- Copy of Certificate of Incorporation and current Business Registration for non-member applicants.
 - Non-Member Applicant's company Profile and 2 samples of its commercial recordings.
