-  Proof of Release
-  Re-recording Permission if relevant

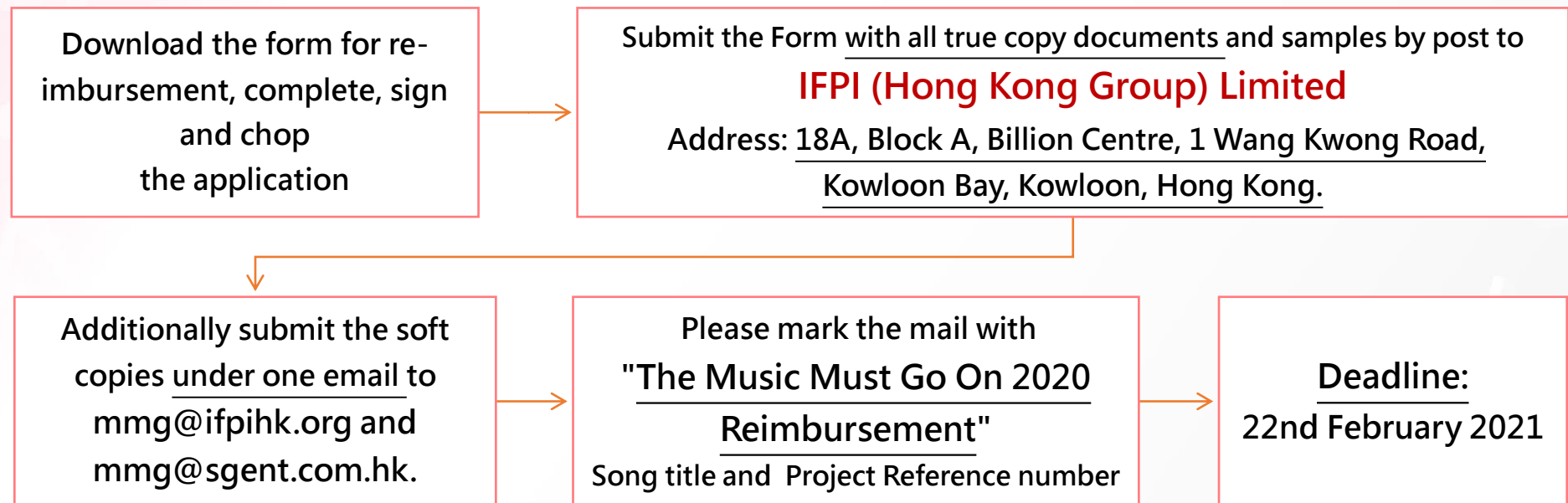
Before Applying, please prepare all of the following

The prerequisite is the approve funded project has been completed fully on or before 30th January 2021



-  Full set of invoice from service providers, each Studio Practitioners with ID, and authorization to pay a company (if relevant).
-  Cover Design of the Single.
-  Artiste Photo for the Release.
-  Sample of promotion, marketing, advertisement, chart success (if any).

Submission of Application for reimbursement



Review by the Liaison Manager



Whether the applicant has completed the project successfully for eligibility to subsidy.



The total amount to be received by the Applicant per project including the disbursement to each Studio practitioners and services.

Note : Costs over and above the allowed subsidy limit is born by the Applicant

Confirmation by the Organizer



After validation confirming the successful project completion, the Organizer will issue a signed confirmation.



The subsidy in 80% and balance payment will be issued promptly.
Note: The subsidy received are not tax exempted.
